The objectives of our Work Health & Safety Policy are:

- To achieve an accident free workplace.
- To make health and safety an integral part of every operation performed.
- To consult with our workers to ensure health and safety is considered in all planning and work activities.
- To involve our employees in the decision making process through regular communication, consultation and training.
- To provide a continuous program of education and learning to ensure that our employees work in the safest possible manner.
- To identify and control all potential hazards in the workplace through hazard identification and risk analysis.
- To ensure all potential accident/incidents are controlled and prevented.
- To provide effective injury management and rehabilitation for all employees.
- To comply with relevant WHS legislation and other requirements.

The success of our WHS management is dependent on pro-active planning, communication and co-operation therefore, while at work, all employees, irrespective of their position shall:

- Take reasonable care to ensure good health and safety procedures are implemented at all times.
